Combining work from home with extensive travel for onlocation shoots, allows Paul the flexibility to capture diverse environments and meet the needs of clients globally. He also dedicates his time to charity and volunteer projects in places like Cambodia, Indonesia, and Australia, using his skills for a greater purpose.
