PCYC NSW is a unique youth charity dedicated to empowering young people to reach their potential through Police and community partnerships. The organisation focuses on early intervention to prevent and disrupt crime and positively influence its members, diverting them from the criminal justice system.

"PCYC NSW provides quality activities and programs in safe, welcoming and nurturing environments," says Stephen Jordan, Club Manager at PCYC Coffs Harbour. "One such initiative is RISEUP – a strategy developed by the NSW Police Commissioner to connect disengaged young people to



workplace opportunities. As part of RISEUP, Coffs Harbour PCYC offers the Fit for Life program. We pick up our youth members at 6 AM, take them to our club, play sports, cook them breakfast and then drive them to school. It's a great program, as many of these kids don't usually have breakfast. Equipping the Club with ASUS ExpertBook B5 Flip laptops has brought us into the 21st Century, enabling us to establish a tech area and expand our RISEUP initiatives to include the life-changing Fit to Learn and Fit for Work programs."

In addition, our members often use the ExpertBooks to earn the accreditations they need for employment, such as White Cards for construction work or first aid certification."

"Previously, we'd been mostly limited to servicing the Melbourne area, whereas now we are moving to an online business model, where we're able to look after clients all over Australia.

We'll need strong and reliable technology underpinning this and that's where we'll continue to turn to ASUS. In an online world, technology is central. We need good systems in place that clients can rely on as we handle sensitive financial issues and details."

"Because the ExpertBooks are smaller, lighter, more powerful and have allday battery life, we can use them all over the club instead of being stuck in a certain area," continues Stephen. "Their 360° flippable hinge enables our youths to unplug, collaborate, share content, and draw and create in tent and tablet modes. We'll shortly be taking our ExpertBooks with us when we visit schools and remote regions, and the flippable design helps us with this outreach program.
